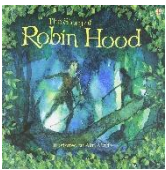

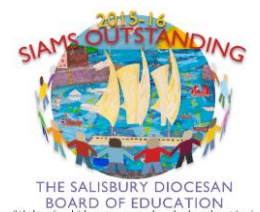
Goodbye to Amesbury

Our final celebration will be on Wednesday 24th July at 1:30pm in the school hall. We will dazzle you with songs, anecdotes and all that jazz.

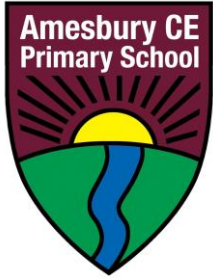
DEAR Time

We have noticed a few changes from the required school uniform. In particular, shoes are an issue as they must be black. Please see the table below.

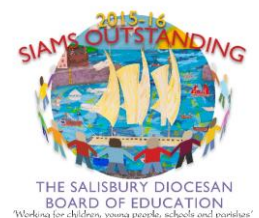

The citizen challenge

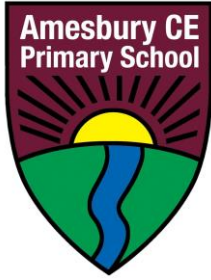

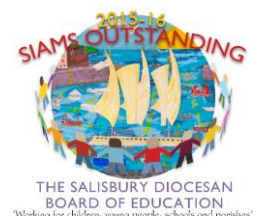
