

AVEBURY AND STONEHENGE

Topic

Through our topic we will immerse ourselves in jungle life. We will understand: who the Mayas were; their rituals and beliefs; why they were considered an advanced civilisation; the links to chocolate production and what caused them to disappear.



Science

In science, the children will be investigating: why are there so many mirrors on cars? They will revise how light travels, how we see objects and how shadows are created.

PE
