



### History

In Term 1, the children will be focusing on British Pre-History. We will be learning about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and how our ancestors changed from nomadic hunters to settled farmers.

### French



This year the children will be learning French for the first time. They will start by learning to understand and follow instructions, name parts of the body, identify colours and say what they are wearing.

### P.E

PE this term will be Football and Team Games. The children will work on technical skills as well as team work and sportsmanship.



### Spelling

In spelling, the children will develop on their phonics and begin to learn and understand different spelling rules. We'll start by learning prefixes and suffixes as well as apostrophes for contractions.

### English

In our English lessons this term, the children will be immersing themselves into many writing styles through engaging texts. The children will write stories, instructions and information leaflets. The children will learn new spelling and grammar rules.

### Science



We will learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. We will also identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amounts of nutrition, and that they get this from the things they eat.

### PSHCE/BLP



This term our BLP theme is Respect. This will underpin the children's PSHE work as we work together to create class charters, expectations. We will learn to understand our peers by looking at the effect our behavior has on others..

### Art



We will be creating paintings inspired by marks made by people tens of thousands of years ago in caves across Europe. We will explore colour wheels, pattern making and shading.

### Computing



In term, the children will learn the importance of E-safety. The children will then put into practice what they have learnt by researching information online to create a fact page.

### RE



The children will be looking at the religion of Hinduism through the festival of Light, Diwali. We will ask would celebrating Diwali at home and in the community bring a feeling of belonging to a Hindu child.

### Music



In music, we will be learning about rhythm. The children will be able to identify different rhythms as well as making rhythms using natural resources.

### Maths

Children will be introduced to place value by investigating numbers up to 1000 as well as partitioning and representing three digit numbers in a variety of ways. We will move onto addition and subtraction building on skills so we can learn to add and subtract three digit numbers.
