School uniform reminder

Dear Parent/Carer

We are now in term 3 and I thought it would be useful to remind you of our expectations regarding uniform as I have noticed many children coming into school not wearing the expected uniform.

Please see the table below for acceptable school uniform that we expect to see your child/ren dressed in in school at all times and a list of items below the table that are not acceptable.

ACCESSORIES/JEWELLERY



As part of the expected dress code, the children should not wear nail varnish, fake tattoos, fashion socks that pull up over the knee, or jewellery (except for watches). Any children who have pierced ears should wear small studs and these should be taken out on days when they have PE. If they are unable to take them out they must be covered in surgical tape.

Uniform is part of the school ethos and it is expected that children will come to school looking smart and ready to learn. This includes hair styles, extreme haircuts and hair accessories such as Jo Jo bows are not acceptable. Children who do not conform to the norm in terms of school uniform are often more likely to be bullied and we would like your help to keep this to a minimum. Uniform also helps children to feel proud of the school they attend which in turn helps them to focus on their learning without distractions. We will be sending home reminder slips when we notice children are not following our school rules with regard to uniform.
