Dear Parent/Carer


Tea/Coffee afternoon – Thursday 14th February, 2 pm

- Enhance communication with and between all members of the school community.



All parents and carers of children attending Amesbury Primary will be welcome to attend the Parents’ Forum. It will give you an opportunity to get together on a regular basis with other parents to have your say on what the school is doing well, and ideas of how you feel things could be improved. It can help you get the advice and support to help and encourage your children with their learning.
