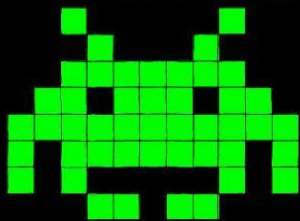


# SPACE INVADERS
