

### Geography

Through our topic we will be exploring settlements. We will be finding out about early settlers and why they settled in different locations. We will also look at the amenities in our local area and compare this to other settlements in the UK. We will conclude by looking at land usage to create our very own model villages perfect for a settler.

### Science

This term we will be studying forces. We will plan and carry out our own investigations observing and measuring the force on objects. We will look at the effects of friction and explain which objects have high or low friction. We will then explore why this is important.

### PE
